



## Joint Committee on Specialist Training

### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS / DOCUMENT(S) REQUIRED FOR SUBMISSION

(Note: Eligibility requirements stipulated in the general call letter apply as well)

#### **PATHOLOGY SEAMLESS PROGRAMME**

For Pathology Seamless Applicant, you are required to fulfil the following:

- a. at least in PGY2
- b. Applicants for Microbiology and Chemical Pathology, are expected to be in their PGY3 prior to commencing traineeship
- c. Applicants for Forensic Pathology are required to have undergone a 6-month posting in Forensic Pathology at the Health Science Authority prior to traineeship application

#### **RADIATION ONCOLOGY SEAMLESS PROGRAMME**

a) All applicants are required to fulfil the admission criteria prior to entry into the Radiation Oncology Seamless programme:

- Completed / completing PG Year 2 by the intake start date including at least 12 months of relevant non-Radiation Oncology clinical postings at Medical Officer level (as per following specialty-list):

##### Medical specialties

1. General Medicine
2. Medical Oncology
3. Geriatric Medicine
4. Gastroenterology
5. Respiratory Medicine
6. Haematology
7. Palliative Medicine
8. Paediatric Medicine

##### Surgical Specialties

1. General Surgery
2. Urology
3. Cardiothoracic Surgery
4. Neurosurgery
5. ENT
6. O&G

Each specialty rotation should not be less than 4 months and is capped at maximum 6 months. Postings must be done in accredited training units. Please check with the JCST secretariat on the accreditation status of the departments. Overseas non-RO clinical postings will not be counted.

b) In addition to the admission criteria in (a), **foreign-trained doctors** who wish to apply for entry into the Radiation Oncology Seamless Traineeship are required to fulfil the following requirements :

- i) Applicants must be employed by MOHH and completed at least 6 months of MO posting in Radiation Oncology at a local institution(e.g. NCC/NUH) upon application for Radiation Oncology Seamless Traineeship.
- ii) A HOD's letter of support on your traineeship application must be submitted but the letter of support is not a guarantee entry into the traineeship. You are required to attend the selection interview and compete with other applicants based on merit.
